number at between 33,000 and 37,000 people), but what is unarguable in Iraq is that it has been costly to all parties involved.

The Army Men Project is meant to reflect these numbers. Armstrong says Drinking Liberally, which meets weekly in West Ashley, has tagged "more than 10 gross" of soldiers with the phrase "Bring Me Home" with the Charleston Peace website (charlestonpeace.net) on the reverse. "We're trying to hit places where people go everyday," she says. We want to make people think about what's going on besides what they see on TV."

Armstrong, a self-described antiwar activist, says it's the least she can do. Too young to act during Vietnam, now she's able to act. "It's better than rioting in the streets-that's not very peaceful," she says.

Although Drinking Liberally is not an antiwar group per se, Armstrong says they loved the idea and decided to participate. "The war is something Drinking Liberally talks about a lot," says Armstrong. Drinking Liberally is a national organization begun in New York City in 2003. The local chapter began meeting last year.

The origin of the name can be discerned from the group's motto: Promoting democracy one pint at a time. "DL is a place where progressive, liberal thinkers can get together and share ideas," says Armstrong. "The cool thing is there's such a diversity of people that come to the meetings. Political candidates have come. Even a few conservatives have
